June 29, 2016	Approval to advertise the Tentative Budget and Millage Rates for 2016-17
June 29, 2016	Approval to expend between July 1 and the adoption of the tentative budget
July 1, 2016	Property Appraiser Certifies the Tax Roll
July 16, 2016	Dept. of Revenue Certifies Taxable Value to the Commissioner
July 19, 2016	DOE computes required local effort millage and certifies rate to each district
July 22, 2016	First Public Hearing advertised in the local newspaper per Truth in Millage (TRIM) requirements
July 25, 2016	Public Hearing and Adoption of Tentative Millage Rates and Tentative District Budget
By Aug. 4, 2016	Superintendent advises Property Appraiser of the proposed millage, rolled-back rate, time, date and place of the final budget hearing
By Aug. 24, 2016	Property Appraiser prepares notice of proposed property taxes and mails TRIM notice
Sept. 13, 2016	Public Hearing and Adoption of Final Budget
By Sept. 16, 2016	Superintendent certifies adopted millage to Property Appraiser and Tax Collector. Budget submitted to DOE within 3 business days after adoption (per state board rules).
After Value Adj. Board 3 days after receipt	Property Appraiser notifies taxing authority of final adjusted tax roll (DR-422) School District certifies DR-422 to Property Appraiser. After VAB Hearing the Appraiser extends the tax roll
By Oct. 13, 2016	School District certifies compliance with 200.65 and 200.68 FL. Statutes to the Dept. of Revenue
