

ESOL Endorsement Online Courses for 2019-2020 School Year

Please read carefully as there are new changes happening to the online ESOL Endorsement courses!

- ESOL Endorsement online courses will now be 10-week sessions with specific start and end timeframes.
- Participants enroll through MyPGS; they may enroll up to one week after the course start date.
- Participants must complete the course successfully within the 10-week timeframe. Partial credit or extensions will not be given.
- Points will only be awarded at one time at the conclusion of the course and after work is graded; **points will not be awarded early** even if the participant has finished the coursework early.

Category III – ESOL 18-hour Theory and Practice

OR

Session 2: March 30th- June 5th (will be released in November)

- Participants who fall under **Category II** (Math, Science, Social Studies, Computer Literacy teachers) or **Category IV** (Administrators and/or Guidance Counselors) must sign up for any of the five Category I courses, except for Language and Literacy, since they comply with the 60-hour requirement.
- **Category III** participants (Special Area and Elective teachers) may also enroll in any of the five Category I courses, except for Language and Literacy, and receive 60-hour in service points instead of the 18-hour course.
