Deposit \$112.11 on the 21st of September and it has been deposited into the internal sac account. Discussion on Sunshade purchase using A+ funds.
*** Sunshade Quote** - Top Line Recreation is the district approved company. Quote is 29' x 29' Square Mega Span Shade System with 10' Eave with pier Mounted Columns. \$12,366 for the shade (-3,091.50 25% VCS Discount) +\$1,125 FL Professional Engineer Sealed Drawings and Calculations, +1,338.55 Shipping/Handling, + \$11,463.41 Installation (-\$573.17 VCS Discount) (-\$250 Top Line Courtesy Discount) \$22,378.29.

- 8. District Advisory Council Update.....Ken Dietzel**
The October 7th meeting was a 2-hour virtual meeting. Results of SAT – VCS 2020 seniors outperformed state and national students. October 5 was World Teachers' Day.
FTE week- looking at enrollees in schools and submitting data to the state. We are around 2,000 students short compared to this time last year. VOL has a very large number of students compared to last year. Last year there were 150 students enrolled and this year there are around 8,000 full time and 4,000 part time students. Many students are starting to return to traditional settings. There were 74 teachers displaced and relocated. Master schedule may change, and VCS will try to maintain a normal schedule, IB/AP courses will not be changed. More teachers are anticipated to be returning to the classroom by January 2020.

School Way Café

V. Hansen and H. Demiola spoke about:

School Way Café served approximately 5.4 million lunches or approximately 30,000 lunches every day, 2.6 million breakfasts or 14,400 breakfast every day, and 3.2 million in a la carte sales. We have 68 full kitchens and remained open during the summer to feed the community.

School Way Café is a nonprofit, self-supporting enterprise and receives no funding from the school district. Pizza crust is wheat, slushies are big, coffee bars in high schools are a hit.

Classroom size has not been changed by the state.

Jaimie Hanes: The FFA students must submit 3 prospective buyers by October 16 to be able to participate in the auction. Ms. Haynes encourages you to share this information and reach out to the middle and high school FFA chapter to find out how to be invited to the Volusia County Fair and Youth show. The auction is taking place on November 12.

Election this year Nov.3, Debary Elementary is a polling location.

The Volusia Live option is part of the emergency order by the state. The Volusia Live option was only approved by the state as an alternative through the **first semester**. Part of the Volusia Live plan that was approved was students who are not showing adequate progress will need to return to face-to-face instruction, so that interventions and remediation can take place where needed to help the student succeed. Safety measures have been put into place to help protect everyone at the schools. Students who are not showing adequate progress will be invited to return face-to-face. However, the parent will need to decide what is the best option that is available if they do not want their student to return. All students will return face-to-face in January as Volusia Live will not be an option after the fall unless there is an emergency order. Volusia County has been handling things smoothly as a county.
