**Purpose:** The purpose of the Culinary & Tourism Academy is to assist students in making informed decisions regarding their future academic and occupational goals and to provide information regarding careers in Hospitality and Tourism.

**Criteria for Acceptance:** Students who are considered for this opportunity must be in 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade with a 2.0 GPA and have a passion for cooking and creating ideas for integrating tourism. Students will be chosen based on the answers stated below and overall **student academic and behavioral performance**.

\*Students may be required to audition to show culinary skills and dedication to the Academy after the initial application is submitted.

**Costs to Students:** The initial financial obligation for students in the program will be \$40 for the first semester and a payment of \$40 in January for the second semester. That amount will cover the cost of a Chef’s coat and an academy t-shirt to be worn on designated school days and to academy sponsored events. The remaining fee will be used to offset field trip costs and help pay for kitchen supplies and other materials.

**Behavior Expectations:** It is a great honor to be accepted into our Culinary & Tourism Academy. Therefore, C & T students are held to a higher level of behavioral expectations. Students are expected to display characteristics of perseverance and grit which will assist them in developing a strong work ethic. Students who exhibit consistent or extreme behavior that prevents those characteristics from being displayed by themselves, or their classmates, will be placed on Academy probation; which may result in the removal from the C & T Academy.
