Purpose: Deltona Middle School’s Innovation, Design, Entrepreneurship, and Advertising (IDEA) Academy is a hands-on/minds-on program that offers students a rigorous curriculum driven by creativity, finance, leadership, and entrepreneurship skills in a student-centered environment. Students in the IDEA Academy will design, create, and sell item in a student-run business and will be responsible for maintaining accurate accounting and inventory records.

Criteria for Acceptance: Any current or future 7th or 8th grade student attending Deltona Middle School may apply to the IDEA Academy. Students will be chosen based on the answers stated below and overall student academic and behavioral performance.

Costs to Students: The financial obligation for students in the program will be \$40. That amount will cover the cost of an academy shirt to be worn on designated school days and to academy sponsored events. The remaining fee will be used to offset field trip costs, materials, and event costs.

The Amazing Shake: The Amazing Shake is a competition that all IDEA Academy students will be expected to compete in. The Amazing Shake places an emphasis on teaching students’ manners, discipline, respect, and professional conduct. Prior to the competition, students learn the nuances of professional human interaction as they are taught skills such as how to give a proper handshake, how to network, how to give a successful interview, and how to remain composed under pressure. The goal is to develop poised and ready individuals that can present themselves exceptionally well, given any circumstance that may arise, now or in the future.

Behavior Expectations: It is a great honor to be accepted into our IDEA Academy. Therefore, IDEA students are held to a higher level of behavioral expectations. Students are expected to display characteristics of perseverance and grit which will assist them in developing a strong work ethic. Students who exhibit consistent or extreme behavior that prevents those characteristics from being displayed by themselves, or their classmates, will be placed on Academy probation; which may result in the removal from the IDEA program.

The IDEA Academy is a rigorous hands-on/minds-on program. In the DMS IDEA Academy, teachers are *facilitators* that ensure students become independent learners with the aim of preparing students for future entrepreneurship goals. With that focus in mind, students are required to be the primary active participant in their own learning and education by designing, manufacturing, and selling personalized items they will sell in our student-run business, the Charger Store. This will require students to drive their own learning beyond what they have previously been required to do.
