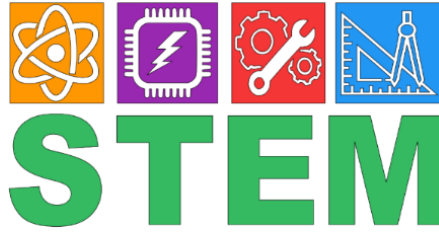

Purpose: Deltona Middle School’s Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Academy is a hands-on/minds-on program that offers students a rigorous curriculum driven by problem solving, student choice, and discovery in a student-centered environment.

Criteria for Acceptance: Any current or future 6th, 7th, or 8th grade student attending Deltona Middle School may apply to the STEM Academy. Students will be chosen based on the answers stated below and overall student academic and behavioral performance. *All students accepted into the STEM Academy will be required to have a PE waiver to participate (see attached).*

Costs to Students: The initial financial obligation for students in the program will be \$40. That amount will cover the cost of an academy shirt to be worn on designated school days and to academy sponsored events. The remaining fee will be used to offset field trip costs, materials, mission fees, and event costs. ****Additional fees may be required if students elect to participate in a particular missions, such as competitions.**

Student Responsibilities: Students will be expected to host and participate in our annual STEM Showcase held in January. In addition, students will be responsible for competing in the Amazing Shake, completing a Genius Hour Project, and taking the District Digital Tools test. ****If students choose to participate in a competitive mission, they will be required to attend after-school meetings and competition events.**

Behavior Expectations: It is a great honor to be accepted into our STEM Academy. Therefore, STEM students are held to a higher level of behavioral expectations. Students are expected to display characteristics of perseverance and grit which will assist them in developing a strong work ethic. Students who exhibit consistent or extreme behavior that prevents those characteristics from being displayed by themselves, or their classmates, will be placed on Academy probation; which may result in the removal from the STEM program.

Person to Contact: Interested applicants should complete the attached document and return it to Mrs. Naylor prior to the end of the March 31, 2020. Selected applicants will be informed of their status in mid-May.

The following questions are to be answered by the applying student:

The STEM Academy is a rigorous hands-on/minds-on program. In the DMS STEM Academy, teachers are *facilitators* that ensure students become independent learners with the aim of preparing students for high school and future careers. With that focus in mind, students are required to be the primary active participant in their own learning and education by completing project-based learning activities (missions), which require students to drive their own learning beyond what they have previously been required to do.

1. If your teacher was assisting another student, and you reach an obstacle in your mission or assignment (such as not knowing how to complete the next step), describe 3 ways/tools you could use to figure out the next step without teacher assistance.

2. Do you believe that your previous teacher would recommend you for the STEM Academy? If so, why? If not, how do you plan on ensuring your next year's teacher would want to recommend you?
