School Uniform 2018-19

At Heritage, our students dress for their role as a student. Our students dress for the business of education.

TOP: Students may wear a **solid** black, green, white, or grey collared polo or button down shirt (blue is not one of the Heritage colors for polos). Stripes and patterns are not permitted. The only garment to be worn over a collared shirt is a hoodie, a sweatshirt, a jacket or a button down sweater. If a student chooses to wear a hoodie, the collar of the polo shirt must be visible *at all times*. The hoodie should be appropriate for middle school. Students are not permitted to wear a long sleeve or short sleeve **shirt** of any kind **over** the collared shirt.

Spirit day: Every Friday is Spirit Day! Student may wear a t-shirt which displays the Heritage name on it. “Team” shirts that are not a Heritage team are not allowed. Heritage spirit shirts are only allowed on *Friday*.

BOTTOM: Students may wear **solid** black, navy blue, khaki, tan pants, grey pants, or blue denim or black jeans. No other color jeans are allowed. Students may also wear solid black, navy blue, khaki, tan, grey, or jean mid-thigh length or longer shorts. **NO** rips, designs, or patterns are allowed on pants. Polo type dresses in school colors are allowed. Solid black, navy blue, khaki, tan, or grey skirts (midthigh length or longer) are allowed.

Leggings, tights, or spandex pants are not allowed. Solid black tights may only be worn under a dress or skirt.

Absolutely no tattered or torn clothing is allowed. At Heritage, **we dress for the business of education.**

Students must wear closed toe shoes with backs. *Absolutely no slides or flip flops are allowed.*

Students may only wear a hood or hat *outside* in 50 degree weather or cooler. A hood or hat should never be worn inside *any* building. Bandanas and sunglasses are not allowed to be worn at school.

Students are expected to dress out after P.E. or dance, so that they are in uniform when they travel through the campus. If students leaves P.E. or dance and they are not in uniform, they will receive a dress code step.
