Are you ready to celebrate until midnight? There will be thrill rides, DJs, Dance parties, Karaoke, Photo Ops, Street Entertainment and more! Gradventure provides a multitude of things for students and chaperones to do in a fun and safe environment.

Our preparations for departure will begin at 2:00 PM and our charter buses will be leaving the school at approximately 2:30 PM. We will return at approximately 1:30 AM to the bus loop at David Hinson Middle School and parents/guardians are asked to be waiting to pick-up their student.

General Rules and Guidelines for all Gradventure Participants:

- I. **School administrators reserve the right to deny participation at this event as a result of student's misconduct! No more than 5 referrals after November 1st. No Out of School Suspension after November 1st. On track to be promoted.**

- II. Student conduct: All students who have paid to attend the Gradventure event and submitted a completed permission form have agreed to follow the rules in the Volusia County School Student Code of Conduct and the directions of school personnel and chaperones during this event or be subject to disciplinary action. *Any student who violates Volusia County School's policies or those of Universal Studios, will be sent home at the parent's expense.*

- III. Security:
 - ❖ Students may bring only **small backpacks and purses**. The Universal Orlando Resort team members and Gradventure Event Staff check all bags, pockets and other items for any illegal substances and weapons. For everyone's security, metal detectors are used to check Gradventure participants at the event entrance. All questionable items will be confiscated at the gate.
 - ❖ No Food, Beverages or Coolers may be brought into the park.
 - ❖ Students will assume full responsibility for possible damage, loss or theft of cameras, cell phones, and other electronic devices and/or personal items that they bring to Gradventure.

- IV. Attendance: Students must attend entire school day of Gradventure to be eligible to attend.
- V. Fun: All students are required to have an enjoyable evening that celebrates their transition from middle school to high school.
- VI. Dress Code (see attached) The T-Shirt that comes with the package to attend Gradventure must not be altered in any way and must be worn to attend the event.
