A Message From Our Assistant Principal

Roadrunner families,

Please review the safety procedures below when it comes to dropping off or picking up at the school:

- Pull all the way forward on Leavitt Ave. before dropping off or picking up
- Put your vehicle in park before permitting your child to enter or exit
- On Leavitt Ave., only enter and exit the vehicle from the sidewalk
- Make sure you have a blue "Parent Pick Up Card" to receive your child
- Utilize the parking spaces on University Ave. in the morning to drop off. If no spaces are available, you must use the parent loop on Leavitt Ave.
- It is a violation of state law to stop on University or Orange Avenues to drop off your children and is extremely unsafe
It is also a violation of law to have cars enter or block the bus loop

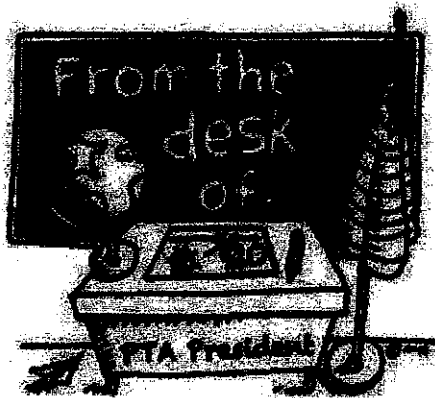
