Remember, showing responsibility can happen every day in every location at school. Being responsible is following ALL of our expectations everywhere.

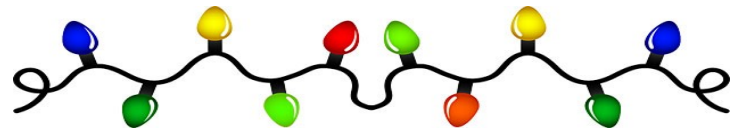
Be Respectful:
