Please take the time to review the following art room rules and expectations; to ensure that everyone can have fun and meaningful art experiences.

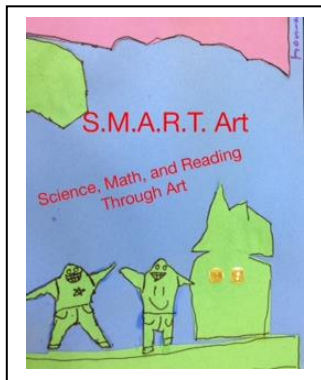
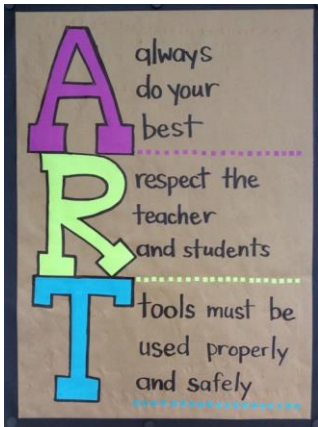
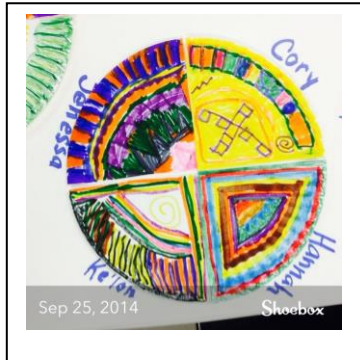
Art Room Rules:
