

SAC Meeting 09 14 2021

Meeting was called to order at 4:09 pm by Dr. Milton.

Welcome- Dr. Milton introduced SAC and stated the purpose of the SAC committee which is to help make school-based decisions.

Introductions- ALL SAC members went around and introduced themselves. We welcomed back parents and returning SAC members Cassie Gonyers and Trista King.

Bylaws- The Turie T Small bylaws were presented. Dr. Milton asked for input. Due to lack of quorum, the bylaws will be readdressed next time and a vote could occur at this time.

Public Comments- It was suggested by Ms. Gonyers to move the start time for meeting. It was also suggested by Ms. Coates to move the meetings to the first or third Tuesday of the month due to the School Board meeting dates. Dr. Milton stated this will be addressed later in the meeting. No other comments were made.

SAC Membership- Dr. Milton reviewed the SAC Membership list (see attached list). SAC Members were added as follows:

SIP Review- Dr. Milton presented information on the school grade. She reviewed the one pager "SIP Action Plan" with all members including the three academic goals and the steps to help us reach the goals. She reviewed current school data and explained how the action steps taking place at the school level help to support the SIP. This included focused data chats and how we analyze the data during PLCs.

SAC Budget Review-

- Last year, we had \$2384.80 left over. This was after using the requests from Johnson for supplements which were discussed at the end of the meeting.
- \$2454.58 was sent by the state- this was from teachers who did not use Teacher Lead Money. Teacher Lead Money is money teachers can choose to set aside and spend. They must submit receipts for reimbursement.
- \$4839.38 is in the current SAC account.
- We have not received the 2021-2022 allocation from the state for this school year for SAC.
- Asking for the following expenditures: \$530 for supplement for Dr. Milton for SAC Chair, School Leadership Team also pays for \$1091 for Rene Fath.
- The decision would be voted on at the SAC meeting.

Principal's Report- Mrs. McAndrew shared about our PBIS initiatives and the new school. PBIS is in place to increase positive behaviors and support our school culture. The new school meetings with the

architecture firm have been productive. They are listening to input from stakeholders. Next meeting is scheduled for the end of the week.

DAC- DAC meets the first Wednesday of the month. They discussed the mask mandate and the layers in place to help. This includes the air turnover rate, plenty of PPE is available. The new COVID decision tree is being used, and wearing masks is the difference between being sent home or not. It was mentioned to bring to DAC about substitute shortage, personnel concerns and the movement of personnel from Turie T.
